Member News and Prayer Requests

Diane passed away early Thursday morning. She had struggled with pancreatic cancer and chemotherapy. In December she became extremely ill from an infection and spent three weeks in Providence Hospital in Everett. She was discharged and spent three weeks with me over Christmas and then was admitted to Virginia Mason in Seattle, where her oncology was being provided, when the infection returned.

It appeared a week ago she might be on a path for discharge once more when the infection reappeared and she became extremely ill again. This time though she had no reserves left and early this morning and the Lord took my mother home.

She fought extremely hard. Every floor she was on, every doctor and nurse that met her and saw how ill she was, and was initially inclined to write her off as just old, and had cancer, soon became aware she was not normal; she had inner strength and patience that came from a source, typical patients did not have. It obviously stemmed from her faith. Tenacious soon became the word they used to describe her. "Bannisters never quit" was written each white board in the various rooms she stayed in and it became known around the floor. When the doctors would ask her if she was ready to quit, and stop fighting she would answer, "No. Not if there's still options to exercise." And she didn't quit, until the road ran out, and God said, "You can stop now. Come home."

She was faithful to the end. There were so many lives she touched in the last two months in each ward she was in. I doubt she knew it. She did express an extreme missing of her families, both physical and spiritual. She loved you all so much and was so wanting to sing and worship with you, to commune with you. The pandemic made that option impossible though, and for her that was probably the worst part of being ill and in the hospital. We will sing and worship and commune with her again someday in heaven.

There are presently no plans for her memorial just yet. The pandemic may make that event have to wait for a while. Just remember she loved and was so appreciative of the love, consideration and help so many of you provided over the years. I appreciated it too.
