Mike has had a pain in his right side for two months and has been off of work. Recently, after three ER visits (one for vertigo), he was referred to a cancer specialist. The doctors suspect some form of Non-Hodgkin's Lymphoma (B cell). This Wednesday he goes in for another CT scan, this time for chest, abdomen, and the pelvic area to locate other lymph node biopsy sites, with a follow up the next week. Mike is getting closer to a firm diagnosis and hopefully a solution and path to follow. Mike and Jerri want to thank everyone for their support, love, and especially the prayers.

Joe was released from the hospital last Monday. The doctors have determined the seizures are stemming from Joe's temporal lobe, but they are unsure which part. The next step is neurological testing, and a panel of doctors will review the information they received. This will, most likely, be a long process before further steps can be decided. Joe's seizure medications were changed, he's not back to his regular self, but otherwise seems to be doing ok. Please continue to pray for Joe, the entire family, and the doctors.

Kim's grandfather, Charles, passed away last Sunday. Kim flew to Pennsylvania to be with her family for the funeral on Wednesday.

Sue (Jesse's mom) required gall bladder surgery last Monday.
