Covid Protocol Changes Effective Immediately

- 1. Overflow room reserved: a mandatory mask wearing policy for anyone older than 5 years is in effect in the overflow room. Signs are posted in the foyer and in the entrance to the overflow room stating this is a mask only area.
- 2. One classroom will be opened as a place for parents to change babies as an alternative to being in a restroom with unmasked members.
- 3. Members can also use the private restroom in the hall by the communion preparation area.
